ORDER

In the G.O. read as Ist paper as amended in the G.Os. read as second and third papers above Government have ordered that all the full time contingent employees of Government, who have been continuously in service from a date prior to 1-4-1965 will be absorbed in the regular establishment with effect from 1-4-1968 and that in future no full time posts borne one contingencies will be created.

2. Government wish to clarify that the intention of the above orders is that no full time appointments will be made under contingency from 1-4-1968 and that full time contingent posts held by employees who have not been absorbed into regular establishment as per the order cited will stand automatically abolished as and when the existing incumbents retire or otherwise vacate the posts. The question whether a corresponding post should be created in the regular establishment consequent on the abolition of the post under contingent establishment may be taken up as and when the necessity arises.
