

Finance Department, Circular, Fin (EB) 3-20989/61-1- dated 15-5-1961

Sub: Allowance – T.A Drawal of T.A for journeys on tour of 20 miles  
And less – instructions issued.

As per Articles 55 of part II, K.S.R. officers not in receipt of P.T.A. have to draw their T.A. for journeys on tour in the form of Dally Allowance 62 A (ii) of Part II , K.S.R. provides that an officer may exchange his D.A for mileage allowance on any day in which he travels more than 20 miles by road. Thus for journeys on tour of 20- miles and below, an officer who is not eligible for any P.T.A can draw only D.A as T.A. But it is brought to the notice of Government that in many Blocks class IV Government Servants are allowed to draw T.A for journeys on tour of 20 miles and less, at the rate of one D.A plus mileage or actual cost. This is irregular.

2. All the Block Development officers are therefore informed that for all journeys in tour of 20 miles and less but not less than 5 miles a day, only D.A. is admissible as T.A to all officers who are not eligible for P.T.A) including class IV Government Servants. All Heads of Departments are also requested to bear in mind the position explained in para (1) for information and guidance.
