Order.

According to rule 119 part III K.S.R.the pay on re-employment is to be fixed with reference to the pay drawn at the time of retirement.According to G.O. (P) 434/60/Fin.dated 8-9-1960 the pay of officers are refixed as on 1—4—1958 with the monetary benefit from 1-4-1960.

The Accountant General in his letter read above has requested clarification whether pay fixed as per G.O. dated 8-9-1960 though under awn may be taken as the pay at the time of retirement for purposes of refixation of pay on re-employment. He has also stated that similar clarification is required in respect of those who were re-employed after 1---1---1959 but who had retired in respect of those who were re-employed after of pay on the junior senior basis.

Government are pleased to order that the pay fixed as per G.O. dated 8-9-1960 though undrawn shall be taken as the pay drawn at the time of retirement for purposes of re-fixation of pay on re-employment. So also the pay the officer would have drawn on junior senior basis shall be taken as the pay drawn by the officer at the time of retirement in cases where the officer had retired prior to 1---11---1956 but re-employed after 1---1---1959.
