Transfers within a period of four months-Drawal of Transfer Travelling Allowance – Clarification – Issued.

ORDER

As per Note (2) to Rule 65, Part II Kerala Service Rules, the Travelling Allowance of officers for journeys on temporary transfers and relieving duties of not more than four months duration, will be limited to the allowance that would have been admissible if such journeys were journeys on tour. It has been defined in Rules ii© of Part II Kerala Service Rules that ‘temporary transfer’ means a transfer to duty in another station which is expressed to be for a period of not exceeding four months.

The Director of Industries and Commerce in his letter read above, requested Government to clarify whether transfer T.A , can be allowed to officers for transfer within a period of four months, it in such transfer orders it has not been expressly mentioned that it is a temporary transfer.

Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order that a transfer which is not specifically stated to be temporary will be treated as permanent. All transferring authorities in cases of temporary transfers or relieving duties should specify in the order of transfer the nature of the transfer.
