Pension – Calculation of Contingency Service interposed between Work Establishment Service and Regular Establishment Service Certification – Issued.

ORDER

In the G.O. read as first paper above it has been ordered that contingent employee who retire from service at the age of 65 will be paid a gratuity at the rate of 15 days basic pay for every completed year of service subject to a maximum of 12 months basic pay. The Accountant General has in his letter cited sought clarification as to how service in the regular Establishments and Work Establishment in between contingency service is to be treated for purposes of calculating gratuity.

After having considered the question Government are pleased to order that Regular Establishment Service as well as work Establishment service in between contingency service will be treated as contingency service for purpose of calculating gratuity under G.O. (p) No 309/59/Fin dated 23<sup>rd</sup> June 1959.
