Sub: Co-option of civilians as Members of Preliminary/Final  
Interview boards fro the Grant of commission in the  
Territorial Army and the grants of TA/DA to them

I am directed to refer to para 7 of appendix VIII to TA Regs. 48 and as convey the sanction of the President to the co-option of civilians of influence, preferably leading educationalists or other civilians possessing technical qualifications, for the purpose preliminary/final interview boards for screening of candidates for commission in the Territorial Army at the Sub Area, Area Headquarters, Command level as the case may be.

2. The civilian members so co opted who are not Government Servant will be entitled to TA/DA for the journeys involved as admissible under this Ministry letter No.P.25(176) – 57/11534/D (RST) dt. The 28<sup>th</sup> December, 1960, as amended vide this Ministry letter No.F.25(176) -57/15735/D(RST 1) dt. The 24<sup>th</sup> January, 1961 and No.F. 25(176)-57 1666/D (Est -1) dt. The 6<sup>th</sup> February, 1961. This claims will be submitted to the ACDA 1/o pay section Western Command 'F' Block, New Delhi, for audit and payment through the Sub Area/Area/Command Headquarters.
3. Civil Government officials if any, co-opted with such interview Boards will be governed by their own civil service rules regarding TA/DA in respect of such officials will be claimed by them from their own State or parent office/Department and will be debited to the Defence Services Estimates. The necessary debit will be raised by the civil Accountant General concerned against the Controller of Defence Accounts western Command Meerat.
4. The expenditure involved will be debitable to the detailed Head 2A (a) (iii) Major Head 58 of the Defence Services Estimates.
