ORDER

Government servants who have been nominated even in their individual capacities to the Committee/Councils specified in para 4 below are authorized to attend the affairs of the Committee /Councils as part of their official duty.

Government also direct that the orders issued in para 1 of R.O.M.S. No.100, finance dated 29-2-1960 will apply of the Government servants referred to in para 1 above. An extract of the relevant paragraph is appended to this order for ready reference.

3. Members of private institution (such as aided school and private colleges) will be eligible for T.A and other allowances according to the Classification of Committees on which they are members or according to the T.A. Rules of the Academy etc.
4. This order will apply to the following bodies only
  1. Advisory Board of the Kerala letters.
  2. Advisory Committee and subsidy Committee of Malayalam Encyclopaedia.
  3. General Council and subsidiary committee of the Kerala Sahitya Academic, Kerala Sangeetha Natak Academy Kerala Lalithakala Academy and the Kerala Kalamandalam.

(Extract of para 1 of G.O MS. No. Finance dated 29-2-1960)

According to the orders contain the G.Os read as first, second and third papers above, an officer of Government required to attend meetings of the Board of Directors or Committee of Industrial concern or Bank or a Joint Stock Company on behalf of Government, shall receive T.A and D.A from Government accorded to rules. The Officer concerned industrial concern or Bank to the receipt and corresponding to the head of account to which his T.A is debited. He has also to forward to the Comptroller in advance a statement of T.A and sitting fee etc., to which he is entitled for attending such meeting in a month so as to enable the comptroller to watch recovery.
