Forest –Department –Establishment-Grant of T.A to Rangers-clarified orders issued.

ORDERS

In the G.O. read above, Government have inter alia ordered that the Range Officers will be allowed regular T.A. for their tours within their jurisdiction, subject to a maximum of Rs. 60/- (Rupees sixty only) per mensum. The Chief Conservator of Forests, in this letter A2-5980/58 dated 13-11-1958 has made the following recommendations.

(i) The minimum T. A limit prescribed for the Rangers may be raised to Rs. 100/- (Rupees one hundred only) as the Rangers will have to do touring work at least twenty days a month. Clarified orders have also been sought for in respect of Rangers who are not in charge of territorial Ranges, such as Rangers on acquisition of Private Forests, Rangers in charge of Flying Squads and Prosecution Rangers.

(ii) Regular T.A may be paid to the Foresters working on acquisition of private forests and in the Flying Squads in the Department apart from the F.T.A that is now being paid to them.

2. Government have examined the above recommendations. They do not find any justification to enhance the limit of T.A of Rs.60/- (Rupees sixty only) in the case of Rangers. However, the three categories of Rangers mentioned by the Chief Conservator of Forests, viz Rangers on Acquisition of Private Forests, Rangers in charge of Flying Squads and Prosecution Rangers will be allowed to draw regular T.A. according to rules, subject to a limit of Rs. 60/- (Rupees sixty only) per mensum.

3. As regards recommendation (ii) the Chief Conservator of Forests is informed that the orders in.G.O. MS. No.434/58/Fin. dated 18-11-1958 will apply to these Forests also.
