**ORDER**

The three wood working units of SIDCO were set up for entering to the needs of wooden furniture by Govt. Departments and institutions. At presents there units get only 5% price performance over the lowest rate containe4d in open tender, whereas the product of these units suffer excise duty apart from ST and AST. The private SST units are exempted from payment of excise duty and ST under various Acts and Rules and thereby it is quitters evident that SIDCO'S unit have to exorbitant rates and they cannot compete with other private firms in open Tender and this seriously affects the working under SIDCO, Govt.are pleased co. order that all Government Departments (Except schools will purchase their requirements of all types of wooden furniture from SIDCO without following Tender formalities for period of one year from the date of issue of this order in relaxation of Para 57 (n) (3) of stores purchase of Manuals. The price will be fixed by a committee consisting of cost Accoutant,and Industrial Engineer and representatives of SIDCO , the purchasing department and stores purchase department. The position will be received after one year if found necessary.
