O R D E R

In the Government Order read above, orders were issued evolving formulae for conversion of volume into weight in respect of Eucalyptus. The Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter read above, pointed out that the Government Order requires revision.

2. Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to revise the formulae, accepted in the Government Order read above as follows:

(1) <u>Wood without bark:-</u> Species.	<u>Equivalent weight with bark in tonnes of 2m<sup>3</sup> wood without bark</u> (In round)	
(a) Eucalyptus terreticornis	1.8331 tonne	1.8 tonne.
(b) Eucalyptus Grandis	1.5880 tonne	1.6 tonne.
(2) <u>Wood with bark:-</u> Species.	<u>Weight in tonnes of 2m<sup>3</sup> wood with bark</u> (In round)	
(a) Eucalyptus terreticornis	1.4705 tonne	1.5 tonne.
(b) Eucalyptus Grandis	1.3710 tonne	1.4 tonne.
