Abstract

Government servant's conduct Rules- Special property statements orders Issued.

ORDER

Under rule 38 of the Kerala Government servant's conduct rules 1960, the Government order that the officers listed in the appendices to this order shall submit before 15-3-1976 a special property statement as on 1-1-1976 containing the following particulars.

- i. A list of immovable properties (with descriptions on locality, area etc.) held by the officer in his name, in his wife's name, in his children's name and in any one else's name
- ii. A list of Movable properties each of the value of Rs.1,000/- and above on the date of acquisition, owned by his wife and dependent children.
- iii. Gold and gold Ornaments, if they exceed 15 sovereigns in all belonging to this his wife and dependent children.

14. All other assets whether in his name or held in somebody else's name such as bank deposits, securities, shares etc.

Note:- Against each of the above items, the officer should indicate the date of acquisition, amount paid at the time of acquisition and the source from which he paid for them

2. The officers mentioned in appendix I of this order should submit the special property statement direct to the secretary to Government noted against their names, who shall be the custodian in respect of such statements.
3. The officers mentioned in Appendix II should submit the special property statement to the head of the Department concerned who will scrutinize the statements and forward to the Secretary to Government in the administrative Department such of those statements, which he feels should be brought to the notice of Government.
4. Where any of the posts mentioned in the appendices are held by officers of All India services they will be covered by the existing instructions under the All India service Rules on the subject.
5. Government wish to make it clear that suppression of relevant facts or giving false statements in the special property statements would be taken serious notice of and dealt with severely.
6. The Officers concerned may note that the special property statements called for here in are in addition to the usual annual return being furnished by them.
