O R D E R

In G.O. (MS) No. 403/78/AD dated 23.8.1978 orders have been issued prescribing a pass in the Departmental examination both in the lower and higher standards as a precondition for promotion of a Junior scale IAS officer to the senior scale of the Indian Administrative Service.

2. By the orders issued in G.O. (Rt) No. 3336/79/GAD dt. 25.5.1979 the above orders have been made applicable to the Indian Police Service and Indian Forest Service Officers of the Years of allotment 1977 onwards also.

3. Government have reviewed these orders, Government hereby order that Junior scale officers of the IAS IFS/ IFS, who have completed four years of service and who have passed departmental tests, except the language test, will be eligible to be promoted to the senior scale, subject to the condition that they will be eligible for increment in the senior scale only after passing the language test.
