S.R.O.No.569/77- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub section (1) of section 2 of the Kerala public service Act, 1968 (19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Kerala state and subordinate service rules), 1958, namely:-

AMENDMENT

In part II of the said rules, in sub rule (d) of rule 9, after the opening words “Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules”, the words “or in the Special Rules” shall be inserted.

The amendment hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force with effect on and from 1st June 1977.

Explanatory note

(This note is not a part of the Notification but is intended to indicate its general purport). Rule 9 (d) of the general rules provides for making out of turn promotion of persons with knowledge of a regional language notwithstanding anything contained in the general rules. But this provision is found to be G 1131 ineffective wherever the special rules also do not contain similar specific provision. So it is found necessary to make rule 9 (d) independent of the special rules. The above amendment is intended to achieve the above object.
