ORDER

Para (ii) of the G.O. read above depts. with rule regarding the fixation of pay of transferees. It has been ordered in that para interline that the dearness allowance drawn by the office on the date of pay revision in the states of Madras/Mysore will be deducted from the pay on the date of transfer and his pay will be fixed at that stage if it is a stage in the state scale of pay and he will be allowed to count his service at that stage for the grant of future increments. A doubt has now arisen as to whether the dearness allowance on the date of pay revision mentioned above is the dearness allowance drawn in the old scale prior to revision or the dearness allowance drawn in the new after revision.

Government are pleased to clarify that the dearness allowance drawn on the date of pay revision mentioned in para (ii) of the G.O. MS. 347/ public dated 23.6.1962 is the dearness allowance drawn in the old scale prior to the merger of dearness allowance in pay.
