ORDER

His Excellency the President of India has outlined ten missions for Kerala's Prosperity in his address of the Legislative Assembly on 28.7.2005 and subsequently six more Missions were added considering the overall needs of the state. A detailed action plan has been prepared for the implementation of the Missions. The estimated total cost of the projects over a period of five years is Rs. 13495/- crore. The amount is expected from private sector, financial institutions, Government of Kerala and Government of India. It is proposed to implement the projects by dovetailing the existing state plan schemes, centrally sponsored schemes and plans of local Governments. An amount of Rs. 40.00 crore has been earmarked for implementation of the projects during 2006-07. In order to implement the projects a fast track mechanism is needed to realize the outputs within the stipulated time frame.

2. In the circumstances, Government are pleased to approve the constitution of an Empowered Committee with the following composition.

3. The Terms of Reference of the committee are:

- (i) To issue detailed guidelines for the implementation of the projects.
- (ii) To issue Administrative sanction for all projects with an annual cost upto Rs. 15.00 crore
- (iii) To review the implementation of the projects periodically.

4. The Government are also pleased to order that the Centre for Management Development (CMD) and Centre for Development of Imaging /Technology (C-DIT) will be monitoring and visual documentation agencies for the projects, respectively.

5. Government are also pleased to order that the outputs and monitorable targets for all the projects would be finalized by the State Planning Board based on the detailed Project reports prepared by the implementing agencies. The State Planning Board will be the nodal agency for monitoring the Missions.
