ORDER

According to the Government orders read above, non-permanent Government employees who are permitted by a competent authority to apply for and take up appointment under another State Government or the Government of India are allowed to revert to the State Government Service at any time during a period of two years from the date of relief. At the end of two years, they are to be deemed to have resigned from the State Government Service, if they do not so revert.

2. In partial modification of the above orders, Government direct that such non-permanent officers who do not revert to the State Government Service within the stipulated period of two years be removed from service following the procedure laid down on the disciplinary rules applicable to them.
