**ORDER**

In the Government Order first read above, rule 4 of the Kerala State and Subordinate Service rules, 1958 was amended to provide that a candidate who is an Ex- Serviceman released on completion of his “normal tenure of service” from the Defence Forces may apply for appointment to post in the sub ordinate services in a form with only one fourth the amount of the prescribed fee embossed thereon. In the G.O third read above this concession was extended to those personnel for applying to posts in the Government owned companies and corporations carrying a scale of pay, the minimum is which is less than Rs. 500. In the Letter forth read above the Kerala Public Service Commission has requested Government to define the expression “normal tenure of service”.

2. In consultation with the Government of India in the Ministry of Defence, Government direct that the expression “normal tenure of Services” will mean as follows:-

**Army Personnel**

(a) Group I listed in Annexure “A”

Period of engagement 15 years with the colours and 2 years in the reserve or till the attainment of 40 years of age, whichever is earlier.

(b) Group II listed in Annexure “B”

Period of engagement 18 years with the coloures and three years in the reserve or till the attainment of 46 years of age, which ever is earlier.

Naval anf Air force Personnel:

For all ranks and trades- 15 years of regular services.
