S.R.O.No. 758/81. –In exercise of the powers conferred by subsection (1) of section 2 of the Kerala Public Service Act, 1968 (a19 of 1968), read with section 3 thereof, the Government of Kerala hereby make the following amendment to the Special Rules for the Kerala Last Grade Service published under Notification G.O. (P) No. 82/Pbulic (Rules) Department dated the 8th March 1966, in Part I of the Kerala Gazette No. 14 dated the 5th April, 1966, as subsequently amended namely:-

AMENDMENT

In the said rules, in rule 1, the following Note shall be inserted at the end, namely:-

“Notes: - The higher grade posts created for the purpose of giving time bound promotion to member holding any of the categories of posts in the service shall also be treated as posts in the last grade service”.
