ORDER

In his letter No. FAD/VI/9-2/55-56/208 dated 21-2-1959 addressed to the chief conservator of Forests, the Comptroller has pointed out that according to the procedure hitherto followed in the forest Departments, the amounts credited under forests Deposits through the monthly accounts of the Divisional Forest Officers, are not treated as lapsed even after three complete years since the amount fall due for final payment. He has suggested that as the accounting procedure now in vogue in the Forest Department is similar to that followed in the public Works department; the system followed in the P.W.D. of treating the deposits to lapse after three complete years from the date of maturity of the claim may be adopted in the Forest Department also.

Government have examined the above proposal of the Comptroller in detail and order that Forest deposits will be treated to have lapsed after three complete years from the date of maturity of the claim similar to the public Works Department deposits.
