ORDER

According to Rule 18 (a), part II, Kerala Service Rules, an Officer of the Ist Grade is entitled to accommodation of the Ist Class for the highest class by whatever name it is called while undertaking journeys by railway. But it is laid down in Note 1 under the rule that air conditioned accommodation is not recognized as a class of accommodation for this purpose but that, however, First Grade Officers may travel by air conditioned accommodation subject to the recovery of 13 paise per 10 kms. or part thereof.

The question of amending this rule in respect of higher grade officers has been engaging the attention of Government for sometime past.

Government are now pleased to order that officers in the pay scale. Minimum of which is Rs. 1,050 or above, will be eligible to travel by air conditioned accommodation without effecting the recovery of 13 paise per annum or part thereof as laid down in note I under Rule 18 Part II, Kerala Service Rules.

Necessary amendment to Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
