Forests – Land – Encroachments - Evictions from - General Instructions - issued.

ORDER

It has been brought to the notice of Government that some persons who were allowed to continue to be in possession of forests lands encroached up on by them prior to 26-4-1957 are trying to expand their possession by further encroachments. It was with a view to give some relief to the landless poor peasants who had no land of their on, that Government ordered that encroachers who were in occupation of the land prior to 26-4-1957 need not be evicated. Government consider it undesirable to allow encroachers prior to 26-4-1957 to continue in the encroached area, if they try to expand their possession by further encroachments. Government therefore, order that persons who are in possession of forests lands by encroachment prior to 26-4-1957 and who are trying to expand their possession by further encroachment should on being convicted of further encroachment be evicted summarily from the forest lands including the land in their possession prior to April 1957.
