

Copy of the letter No.63566/F3/76/AD-1 dated 12-8-1976 from the Secretary to Government to the Chief Conservator of Forests, Trivandrum.

Sub:- Smuggling of timber sales.

It has been brought to the notice of the Government that several pieces of valuable timber logs, seized while smuggling, are left in the Forests without being transported to the depots. It is also seen that an action has been taken to far for transporting this valuable timber because of some difficulties regarding the rates for transport dragging etc. Government considered that all such pieces of timber which would fetch very good revenue, if they are collected and put to auction in time should be transported to the depots without any more delay.

I am therefore, to request you to send specific proposals on this regard to Government, if necessary.
