

Copy of Letter No.C1-26976/74 dated 11-6-74 from the Chief Conservator of Forests to all D.F.Os.

Sub:- Retention of Rosewood Trees – Clear felling coupes

In this office Circular No.16/73 communicated in No.C1-55523/72 dt. 5-4-73 it was ordered to retain Rosewood trees in conversion areas upto a limit of 75cm. at breast height. From experience, it is noticed that some of the trees are subjected to wind damage. The heaviness of the crown may be one of the reasons for wind damage. In such cases, the Divisional Forest Officers may inspect the trees and if it is having a heavy crown and is likely to be damaged by wind attack, arrangements may be made for lopping the branches to reduce the crown size of the trees.
