ORDER

In the Government Order read as first paper above it was ordered that lumpsum deposits in General Provident Fund beyond the normal credits will be allowed interest. The Accountant General has pointed out certain problems resulting from such a provision and has requested revision of these orders.

Government have reviewed the matter in detail and are pleased to clarify that interest on lumpsum deposits to General Provident Fund is payable only when such deposits are made on the strength of Government Orders making such deposits compulsory and not when made voluntarily by subscribers as and when they choose to do so.
