ORDER

Government order that the following explanatory note will be added to the existing para 16(24) of the Manual of Disciplinary proceedings.

Explanatory Note.

'In the case of an Officer on duty who is away from headquarters at the time of communicating the order of suspension, will take effect immediately from the time of his return to headquarters. The actual time required for discharging the duty to be performed away from headquarters plus the time required for the return journey to head quarters will alone be allowed in such cases. An officer on duty outside the headquarters shall be informed of his suspension from service by the fastest mode of communication available'
