NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India the Governor of Kerala hereby makes the following amendment to the Kerala Government Servants Medical Attendance Rules, 1960 issued with G.O.(P) 29/60/Health dated 12-1-1960 and published in the Kerala Gazette No. 6 dated the 9th February 1960, namely

AMENDMENT

In the said Rules after sub-rule 9 the following shall be added as sub-rule (4), namely:-

- (4) the maximum amount that could be sanctioned to a Government servant for each occasion of illness by the Head of Department is Rs.100. For any amount in excess of Rs.100 Government sanction should be obtained, such sanctions being accorded on the merits of individual cases.
