S.R.O.No.891/81—In Exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Kerala Essential Articles Control (Temporary Powers) Act, 1961 (3 of 1962), the Government of Kerala hereby make the following Order to amend the Kerala Essential Articles (Movement Control) Order, 1981, namely:-

ORDER

1. This Order may be called the Kerala Essential Articles (Movement Control) Amendment Order, 1981.
2. In the Kerala Essential Articles (Movement Control) Order, 1981, for the words “rubber wood” occurring in sub-clauses (b), (d) and (e) of clause 7 and in clause 8, the words “essential articles” shall be substituted.

Explanatory Note

(This does not form part of the notification, but intends to indicate the general purport).

The powers of entry, seizure etc., conferred under clause 7 and powers of the Court to direct forfeiture conferred under clause 8 of the order issued under G.O.Ms No.179/81/Forest(II) dated 20<sup>th</sup> June, 1981 are to be made applicable not only to rubber wood but to all the species of wood declared as essential articles. The above notification is intended to achieve this object.
