CIRCULAR

Sub:- Interval between notification in the Gazette and date of auction or tender

Ref:- Nil

Several instances have come to the notice of the Conservator of Forests that the minimum interval prescribed G.O.No.FB1-24480/60/Agri. Dated 30-05-1960 between the notification in the Gazette and date of auction or tender has not been followed by the Divisional Forest Officers. This is due to the failure on the part of the Divisional Forest Officers to forward the concerned notification for publication in the gazette sufficiently early. If sufficient time is not allowed between the notification and the date of auction or tender, the purpose for which such notifications are published will be defeated. The Divisional Forest Officers are therefore once again requested to adhere to standing orders regarding the minimum period of interval strictly in future. Auction sales or tenders conducted without the minimum period of interval should not be recommended for confirmation. If the cancellation of any sale or tender is necessitated simply due to the above reason the Divisional Forest Officer will be held personally responsible for the consequent loss, if any, on account of a reauction or retender.
