ORDER

Heads of Departments and other officers have raised certain points of doubt in respect of the orders issued in the Government Orders cited. Government are pleased to issue the following clarifications:

- (i) The benefits of surrender of Earned Leave contemplated in para 3 (a) and (b) of the G.O. second cited can be given independently or in combination if the officer is eligible for the same under the respective Government orders.
- (ii) The benefit of Surrender of Earned Leave for 30 days as per para 3 (a) of the Government Order second cited can be given even before the expiry of 12 months from the date of previous surrender for 15 days as per the Government Order first cited.
- (iii) The orders in the Government Order second cited take effect from the date of issue viz. 26-8-70.
