**ORDER**

In the Government letter read as third paper above, instructions were issued to the Chief Conservator of Forests to arrange for the supply of about 600 tonnes of various types of timber, reeds and bamboos to the Hindustan paper Corporation (P) Limited, New Delhi for factory scale tests subject to realization of cost to be limited to Rs. one lakh.

2. In his letter read as first paper above the Chief Conservator of Forests has reported that the revised requirements of the company are 200 tonnes each of Eucalyptus Grandis and Eucalyptus Hybrid and 250 tonnes of reeds. He has also requested Government to accord sanction of deputing a Forester from Trivandrum Division to Nepa Mills with 6 to 7 logs each of about 4 feet length (6"-8" diameter) of both Eucalyptus Grandis and Eucalyptus Hybrid and 20 Kg. of reeds to be dispatched by passenger trains, for laboratory scale tests.

3. Government have considered the question and are pleased to accord sanction for the supply of 200 tonnes each of Eucalyptus Grandis and Eucalyptus Hybrid, as well as 250 tonnes of reeds to the Hindustan Paper Corporation (P) Limited, New Delhi as desired by them. Sanction is also accorded for the deputation of a Forester to the Nepa Mills with the materials, as indicated in Para 2 above.

4. The cost for collection and transportation and all other incidental expenses like those for the deputation of the Forester to Nepa Mills will be met by the Hindustan Paper Corporation (Private) Limited. The expenditure will be incurred initially by the Department and will be reimbursed by the Hindustan Paper Corporation on presentation of bills by the Forest Department. It is noted that a sum of Rs.50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand) has already been deposited by the Corporation for this purpose.

5. This order is in super session of the instructions contained in the letter read as third paper above.
