Supply of softwood to Industrial concerns – fixing of rate of Kalpine – orders issued.

ORDER

In the Government order read as 1st paper Government have fixed revised rates for supply of softwood for packing case plywood and match wood Industries from 1-4-1971.

The Chief Conservator of Forests in his letter read above has observed that the rate of Kalpine, Karanjili may also be revised. The mellabhom rate for kalpine was fixed as Rs.100/- per cum. from 28-1-1967 in the Government order read as First Paper. But the Chief Conservator of Forests had in December 1970 suggested the revision of this rate for Kalpine as to Rs.120/- per cu.m. when the rate for the other species was recommended as Rs.100/- per cum. As the Kalpine species is costlier than the other varieties of softwood, the Chief Conservator of Forests has suggested that the uniform rate of Kalpine may be fixed at Rs.(120+75) = 195, per cum. from 1-4-1971. The proposal of the Chief Conservator of Forests is approved and sanction is accorded for fixing the uniform rate of kalpine as Rs.(120 + 75) = 195 per cu.m. in which Rs.120/- is the Mellabhom rate and Rs.75/- working charges.
