Government after having considered the question in detail with special reference to the difficulties experienced by officers holding provisional appointments (as provided in rules 9(a)(1) and 31 of K.S.S.Rs.) in the matter of drawing pay and allowances, accept the suggestion of the Accountant General and they order

2. The Accountant General has now pointed out that the number of provisional appointments is steadily on the increase and that the time taken for regularising such provisional appointments usually extends to a few years, resulting in the issue of provisional pay slips at frequent intervals of 3 months and that this has increased the work load in his office and in the Offices of the appointing authorities, besides causing hardship to the Officers concerned. He has therefore suggested that the time limit of 6 months for issuing provisional pay slip in the first instance may be raised to one year and the period of 3 months for renewal may be raised to 6 months at a time.

In the G.O. second cited, it has been ordered that (1) in the case of provisional appointments of gazetted Officers, which require the concurrence of the Public Service Commission, the Accountant General will issue provisional pay slips for a period of 6 months in the first instance and (11) in the case of provisional appointments which require the concurrence of the Public Service Commission and in the case of provisional promotions which require the approval of the Departmental Promotion Committee, the power to request the Accountant General after the first 6 months to issue provisional pay slips for a further period of 3 months at a time, pending regulation of the appointments/promotions will be delegated to the appointing authorities concerned (where the appointing authorities are not Government themselves).
