ORDER

In the G. O. read as first paper above Government issued orders accepting the advice of the Kerala Public Service Commission to discontinue the previous practice of issuing certificates to candidates who passed the Departmental and Account tests conducted by the Commission and instead to introduce the system of publishing the full addresses of the successful candidates with their Register numbers in the Kerala Government Gazette. It was also ordered that the Departmental Authorities should make necessary entries in the Service Books of the candidates concerned by referring to the Gazette in which the results were published by the Commission. In the letter read as 2nd paper above the Commission has pointed out certain drawbacks in this system and has recommended to reintroduce the system of issue of certificates.

Government have examined the question in consultation with the Kerala Public Service Commission and they order the reintroduction of the system of issue of certificates to candidates who pass in full one or more of the tests conducted by the Commission and the discontinuance of the existing practice. A fee of Rs. 5. will be realised for each certificate. This order will apply to departmental tests the results of which would be published after the date of this order.
