It is observed that the plantation journals of older plantations and new plantations are not maintained properly in almost all the Divisions. According to the provisions in the Kerala Forest Code each Forest Division where plantations are raised has to maintain a plantation journal for recording the particulars of the various operations undertaken from survey of the Forest area to the final felling of trees. The plantation journals already maintained are incomplete in-as-much-as details of operations (Pre-planting, planting, cultural operations, thinning etc.) carried out, taungya lease, height growth from time to time, state of health of the trees, Thinnings, done in the past, cost there of etc are not seen recorded. Plantation journal is an important record on the plantations raised, you are hereby directed to gather the above mentioned details on each plantations and post up the details and ~~entries~~ maintain the journal for each plantations upto date. Sustained action should be taken in the matter.
