ORDER

In para 2 of the Government proceedings read as first paper, it has been ordered that in cases where the passing of an examination or test confers on a Government servant the title to any right, benefit or concession they should be deemed to have accrued on the day following the last day of the examination or test which he has passed and where the examination or test can be passed in instalments, the title to the right, benefit or concession will be deemed to have accrued on the day following 'The last day of the examination in the subject or subjects in which he had passed'. In the G.O. read as second paper, the above practice was adopted for purposes of promotions also subject to the conditions that it does not involve change of duties and other conditions specified therein. In the G.O. third read above Government ordered that such of the candidates who come out successful in the departmental tests proposed to be held in July-August 1960 but postponed by the Public Service Commission to subsequent dates may be given the benefits that would have accrued to them as though they passed the tests in accordance with the scheduled dates originally fixed for the postponed tests.

2. Departmental tests were postponed by the Public Service Commission to subsequent dates in 1966 and 1970 also and candidates who came out successful in the postponed examinations were deprived of the benefits which they would have accrued if the tests were not postponed. The question whether the principle accepted in the G.O. read as 3rd paper in regard to postponed tests in 1960 will apply for date benefits in the case of postponed tests in 1966 and 1970 was examined by Government. Government wish to clarify

that the principle accepted in the G.O. read as 3rd
paper in consultation with the public Service Commission
will apply to all cases of postponed tests. Accordingly
those who came out successful in the postponed tests in
1966 and 1970 will also get the date benefits given to those
who passed the postponed test in 1960.
