ABSTRACT

Expeditious disposal of Pension cases-payment of anticipatory pension without the Production of Last Pay Certificate and Non-liability Certificate –Order issued.

ORDER

In G.P.R Dis.20344/53/Fin dated 26-9-1953, it was ordered that Last pay Certificate or Non Liability Certificate need not be insisted on for the grant of anticipatory pension. This position was reiterated in the Circular read above, copy enclosed for ready reference.

2. It has however been brought to the notice of Government that the audit officers are insisting on the production of Non Liability Certificate and last pay Certificate even for the payment of anticipatory pension.

3. In order to obviate the hardship resulting from such delays Government order that the instructions laid down as mentioned in the Circular dated 24-10-1953 will be followed in the sanctioning of anticipatory pension if a case is otherwise normal

4. All the Heads of Department and Offices will see that the instruction regarding the prompt settlement of liabilities in cases in which anticipatory pension has been sanctioned contained in the circular dated 24-10-1953 are also are also followed scrupulously.

CIRCULAR

Sub: - Settlement of liabilities – delay in.

With a view to expediting the payment of anticipatory pension it has been ordered in G.P.R.Dis.20344/53/Fin .dated 26-9-1953 that the issue of anticipatory pension payment orders need not be delayed till the receipt of the no-liability certificate and the last pay certificate payment order. In this connection, Government would like to make it clear to all Heads of department that the sanction of anticipatory pension to any officer

should not result in the relaxation of their efforts to settle the liabilities of retired officers who have been granted anticipatory pensions.

The Heads of Department are also informed that any delay beyond 6 months for settlement of liability of an officer after the issue of the sanction for anticipatory pension, will be seriously viewed by Government. They will forward to Government, monthly statement of cases in which the final pension has not been sanctioned within 6 months of the issue of sanction for payment of anticipatory pension showing the reasons for the delay in each case.
