O R D E R

The State is implementing a Social Forestry Project with World Bank Aid. The Six year Project was started in 1984 at a total cost of Rs. 60 Crores. The main objectives of the project are production of 34 crores of seedlings for distribution free of cost, raising of plantation of fuelwood species in Government land and extension activities to educate people on farm forestry.

The World Bank Mission during the review of their credit Kerala Social Forestry Project being implemented in the State commented that the extension programme in the project has suffered due to inadequate infrastructure facilities and therefore suggested that the Staff component provided in Staff Appraisal Report be put in position to overcome the inadequacy of staff for both extension programme and in the supervisory cadre.

The Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry & Project) has sent proposals for the creation of required posts in the light of the observation made by the World Bank Mission with the approval of the Steering Committee of this project headed by the Chief Secretary.

The Proposals of the Chief Conservator of Forests (SF&P) were examined in greater detail and accordingly Government are pleased to accord sanction for the creation of the following posts in the Social Forestry Wing with effect from the financial year 1988-89 on the lines of the mode of appointment indicated against each category of post.

(ii)	Computer Programmer	- 1	
(iii)	Compilers	- 6	
(iv)	Internal Audit Officer in the Scale of Pay (Rs. 1950 - 2950)	- 1	
(v)	Assistant Internal Audit Officer	- 1	
(vi)	Rangers	- 5	} To be filled up by redeployment.
(vii)	Foresters (Rs. 675 -1125)	- 23	
(viii)	Forest Guards (Rs. 600-950)	- 5	

The Posts which are not borne on the regular cadre of the Forest Department are proposed to be filled up by drafting suitable personnel from other Department on deputation basis and appropriate scales of pay will be fixed.

It is further ordered that a Committee consisting of Agrl. Production Commissioner & Secretary (Forests), Secretary (Planning) and Chief Conservator of Forests (Social Forestry & Project) will select the personnel for appointment to the posts proposed to be filled up by deputation after obtaining panel of names as decided by the Steering Committee of the Project.

It is further ordered that the Chief Conservator of Forests / Prl. Chief Conservator of Forests will take immediate action to fill up the post of Rangers proposed to be filled by redeployment exercise, in consultation with Chief Conservator of Forests (SF&P) during 1988-89.

The expenditure on this account will be met from the provision under "2406- Forestry & Wild Life 01- Forestry -102-Social and Farm Forestry - 02- Eco-Development (World Bank Assisted Social Forestry) Plan.
