Sub:- Payment of leave salary in respect of earned leave surrendered at the time of retirement/ death while in foreign service.

Ref:- Circular No, 33/85/Fin. dated 11-4-1985.

In the circular cited, it was clarified that the payment of leave salary for the earned leave surrendered at the time of retirement / death while in service shall be the liability of the foreign employer.

Surrender of Earned Leave at the time of retirement is a terminal benefit, Terminal benefit, are to be paid by the parent Department. Accordingly Government have reviewed the instruction contained in the circular cited and are pleased to clarify that the liability to pay cash equivalent of earned leave at the time of retirement/ death of an officer, while in foreign service will be the liability of the Government.
