C I R C U L A R

Sub: Public Services- Recruitment to the post of Drivers by transfer from other classes/categories procedure to be adopted in the case of candidates in fling to report for duty within the time limit - instructions issued:-

In the circular 3<sup>rd</sup> cited Government have directed that the maximum period admissible to the candidates advised by District /Divisional Employment Officers for the appointment drivers by transfer to report to duty in the new post will be 30 days from the date of appointment order. It was also ordered post further extension of these will be granted in exceptional cases on merit any Government on the recommendation of the Head of the Department where he is working. The Director of employment has non sought clarification regarding the procedure to be followed in the case of candidates who fail to report for duty within the days time limit or do not move for any extension of time.

Govt. have considered the matter and order that in case the candidate advised for appointment driver by transfer do not report for duty within the 30 days time or do not move for extension of time no envisaged in the circular cited, his advise will be cancelled and the next person in the list will be advised against the vacancy. It is also ordered that extension of time exceeding is days beyond the 80 days time specified in the circular 3<sup>rd</sup> cited will not be allowed on any ground.
