# ORDER

The World Bank Mission has done pre-apprisal of the proposal for the World Bank assisted Forestry Project. Government have constituted a Steering and Finance Committee for the implementation of the Project in the Government order read as third paper above. The project would be for a period of 4 years with a total outlay of Rs. 143.15 crores and the World Bank has sanctioned a PPY advance of Rs.165 lakhs for undertaking various studies, constitutions and training. The need for a well established project cell has been reiterated at the discussion the World Bank Team had with the State and Central Government and also in the Aide-Memore. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Development and Protection) in his letter read as fifth paper above has requested and recommended to constitute a project cell for the implementation, monitoring of the project implementation and also send the proposals for the creation of required staff for the cell.

Government have examined the matter in detail and are pleased to constitute a project cell for the implementation and monitoring of the Kerala Forestry Project during 1997-2000 sanctioned as per Government Order read as 2<sup>nd</sup> paper above with the following staff subject to the following conditions.
