P.W.D WORK Establishment - age of retirement fixed - Government share of Contributory provident Fund to reinstated work establishment employees – clarification - orders issued.

ORDER

In the G.O read as first paper, Government ordered among other things that the reinstated work establishment employees who have not refunded the amounts of retirement benefits drawn by them will not be eligible for any further retirement benefits. The CHIEF engineer has raised the doubt whether such employees are eligible for Government share of contributory provident Fund as per the Contributory Provident Fund Rules. Government recently ordered in the G.O read as second paper that repayment of retirement benefits received by the reinstated work establishment employees need not be insisted on. Having examined the point raised by the Chief Engineer in the light of the orders issued in the GO dated 24th July 1965, Government are pleased to clarify that the period after reinstatement referred to in the Go dated 17th April 1964 will count for all retirement benefits including Government share of Contributory Provident Fund if the employees are otherwise eligible under the rules of the Fund.
