Sub: Provident Fund- General Provident Fund (Kerala)-Measures to ensure compulsory subscription to Provident Fund- Revised instructions issued.

Ref: 1. Circular No.37/66/Fin. (PF) dated 24-5-1966
2. Letter No. PF.1/Ex.9-299/66-67/666 dated 25-7-1966 from the Accountant General.

In the Circular cited it has been directed interalia that gazetted officers and non-gazetted officers drawing their own pay bills who do not make any deductions towards General Provident Fund shall furnish the following certificate in their pay bills for the month of July 1966.

“Certificate that I am not required to join General Provident Fund Kerala), since I have insured my life in the State Life Insurance (Official Branch) I had not completed one year of service as on 31-12-1965”.

The Accountant General has now brought to the notice of the Government that difficulties may arise in the encashment of the bills in respect of the gazetted officers and non-gazetted officers drawing pay on separate bills who might have already sent applications for admission to Provident Fund to the office but have not received intimation regarding the allotment of accountant members. With a view to preventing such a contingency, the Accountant General has suggested that the certificate prescribed in Para 2 (a) of the regular may be suitably revised.

Government are pleased to accept the suggestion of the Accountant General. Accordingly the following certificates will be substituted for the existing certificate under Para2 (a) of the circular cited.

“Certified that I am not required to Join General Provident Fund Kerala), since I have insured my life in State Life Insurance/ (Official Branch)/ I had not completed one year of service as on 31-12-1965/I have been exempted from joining the Fund under orders issued in G.O.....dated----- ”

OR

“Certified that I have applied to the Accountant General for admission of the Fund ”.
