General , Kerala, and Trivandrum

In Circular No 81/88/ Fin dated 28-10- 1988. clarification have been issued as to how cases of retention beyond superannuation are to be dealt with and regulated.

The Accountant General in his letter cited above has now requested to clarify as to how the leave account in such cases of retention beyond the date of normal superannuation is to be maintained as the circular referred to above are silent on the aspects .

Government have examined the question in detail and with to clarify as follows :-

(1) The leave account may be closed and balance of leave worked out on the Normal date of superannuation .

(ii) During the extended period , the leave will be earned in terms of the provision in Appendix v11 of kerala service Rule .

(iii ) The balance of leave at credit as on the date of superannuation under (1) Above will be carried over and allowed to avail of / surrendered along with the Leave earned during the extended period under item (2) above .

(iv) On final termination the balance of leave at credit will be permitted to be Enchased .
