ORDER

In the letter cited, the Accountant General has stated that the arrears of dearness allowance due to State Government officials on deputation to the various Central Government Departments were credited to their General Provident Fund (Kerala) accounts in a number of cases, on the basis of the orders issued by the Government of India applicable to the Central Government employees. He has now sought clarification regarding the procedure to be followed for crediting the arrears of dearness allowance of such State Government officials on deputation to the Central Government department to the General Provident Fund (Kerala) and its subsequent withdrawals with interest in accordance with the orders issued by the Government of India.

After examining the question in all its aspects the Government pleased to order as follows:-

(i) 50% of the dearness allowance deposited by the State Government servants on deputation to the Central Government department for the period from 1-6-1974 to 31-12-1974 will be refunded to them with interest.

(ii) 50% of the arrears of dearness allowance subsequently sanctioned to the deputationists need not be deposited by them to their General Provident Fund accounts.
