### **ORDER**

In the Office Memorandum read above, the Government of India have ordered that a Central Government Servant who applied for commutation of pension within one year of the date of his retirement on superannuation will not be subjected to medical examination as required under the rules for purpose of commuted value.

- 2. Government have considered the question of extending the benefit to the State Government Employees and are pleased to order that State Government employees and are pleased to order that State Government servants who apply for communication of pension within one year of retirement on superannuation will not be subjected to medical examination for purpose of payment of commuted value.
- 3. These orders will take effect from the date of issue. These orders will Also apply to those who have retired before the date of issue but have not crossed the age next birthday after superannuation and have not gone before a medical board. These orders will not however apply to persons retiring otherwise than on super annuation.
- 4. Necessary amendments to the relevant rules in Part III Kerala Service Rules will be issued separately.
