PRODEDURE REGARDUNG RECOVERY OF PENSION AND LEAVE CONRIBUTIONS FROM STATE GOVERNMENT SERVANTS DEPUTED TO STATE GOVERMNET OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS/UNDERTAKING ETC ORDERS ISSUED

ORDER

According to the existing rules pension and leave salary contribution of offices deputation to government owned / controlled bodies at the rate of one-sixth and one – twelth respectively of the officer's pay and Dearness Pay are coverable from the foreign employer. However in cases where the foreign employer agrees to grant and leave salary to the deputations, pension contribution alone is recoverable.

- 2. The Accountant General in his letter cited has suggested that recovery of leave salary contribution from the foreign employer may be dispensed with altogether in the interest of simplification of work and procedure.
- 3. Government have examined the question in detail and are pleased to order that the system of recovery of leave salary contribution from the foreign employer in respect of government Officers serving on deputation on foreign terms in state government owned or controlled undertaking be dispensed with . It is also ordered that if an officer avails of leave while on duty in Foreign Service the full expenditure should be borne by the concerned foreign employer and if the leave is taken after return from Foreign Service the expenditure will be borne by government. In regard to the recovery pension contribution, the existing procedure will continue.
