**ORDER**

In the Government Order read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above, it was ordered that in the case of new entrants in Government Service Life Insurance with the State Insurance Official Branch will be compulsory. The present rates of premia were fixed after 1978 Pay Revision. Government have since ordered a general pay revision with effect from 1-7-1983 to the State Government employees. The Director of Insurance in his letter 2<sup>nd</sup> cited has therefore proposed to enhance the existing rates of Life Insurance Premia inconsonance with revised scales of pay.

Government have examined the matter in detail and have decided to fix the following revised monthly rated of premia with effect from 1-7-1986.
