**ORDER**

In the Government of India O.M read first paper above , orders have been issued to count the service of central Government employees , employees , going over to central Autonomous Bodies for pension for pension subject to certain conditions . In the letter cited second paper above , Government of India have agreed to extend the benefit of the above orders to employee of central Government absorbed in the state Government and state .Autonomous Bodies and vice versa and the orders in this respect in this respect have to be issued by the respective State Government .

2 The question of extending this benefit to the employees of State Government going over to Central Government / Central Autonomous Bodies was under the consideration with Government of India and are pleased to order that where a State Government employee borne on pension able establishment is allowed to be absorbed in Government of India /Autonomous Body , the service rendered by him under the Government shall be allowed to be counted towards pension under Government of India /Autonomous body irrespective of whether the employee was temporary or permanent in Government . The same procedure will be applied on the case of employees of Government of India, Autonomous Bodies who are permanently absorbed under the State Government / State Autonomous Bodies.

3 The Government /Autonomous Body will discharge its pension its pension liability by paying in lump sum as a one –time payment , the prorate pension /service gratuity terminal gratuity and Death -cum -retirement Gratuity for the service up to the date of observation in the autonomous body /Government as the case may be , Lump sum amount of the pro-rata pension will be determined with reference to communication table laid down in kerala Services Rules part 111.
