**ORDER**

The Government of India in the reference 2<sup>nd</sup> cited have decided to delete the requirements of personal appearance in case of physically handicapped pensioners who is unable to present himself /n herself at the paying branch , . The Government are also pleased to introduce similar benefits to such handicapped pensioners of the State by adding the following as sub Para (iv) under para8 (2) of the G.O read as 1<sup>st</sup> paper above .

“ (iv) In case of a physically handicapped pensioner who is unable to present himself /herself at the paying branch the requirement of personal appearance shall be waived . Instead thereof , the officer in charge /Bank Manager as the designated officer may visit the pensioners residence / hostel for the purpose of identification and obtaining specimen signature etc.. As required in such Para (i) to (iii) above. For this purpose the pensioner shall submit to the branch of the public Sector Bank a certificate from a medical practioner about his / her being physically handicapped”
