ORDER

The Comptroller has brought to the notice of Government the difficulties to keep pending in his register, items of applications for house construction advances for indefinitely long periods, for want of sanction with a view to avoid accumulation of applications and to delete absolute items from the registers, he has suggested to fix a time limit within the sanction should be accorded failing which the applications are to be taken as rejected and a fresh application is to be insisted upon if the party wants to get the advance. Government are pleased to order that a period of six months from the date of application will be fixed as a suitable time limit for the closure of files, if no sanction is accorded within that period.

ORDER

It is laid down in the rules governing the grant of house construction Advances to Government servants, approved in the G.O read as first paper above. (clause 4 rules 4) that when the advance is paid in installments repayment shall commence from the fourth issue of pay after the first installments taken and when paid in one installment, with the first issue of the pay. The advance is usually paid in two installments, when the site has to be purchased first, and house built later on. Government have further considered the question and are now pleased to order that the repayment of the advance drawn for House construction purpose will commence only after the expiry of the six months from the date or dates of disbursement of the installments. This concession will not be available to those who purchase a built house outright.

This rule issued in the Government Proceedings read as first paper above are modified to the above extent.
